Main Issues in the area for the month of March are:

- The subject of road safety has been raised in relation to the B4245. There have been concerns that vehicles are driving at excessive speeds down the road. Random speed monitoring will take place in the area to deter speeding and to monitor the speed of oncoming vehicles. The data from the speed checks will establish the extent of the issue and foster collaborative working to address it.
