The crime data above shows the recorded incidents within the specific ward area for Rogiet.

Over the last month, 10 crimes have been recorded in Rogiet.

There has been a decrease in the number of crimes reported in the Rogiet area from 12 to 10- since last month's report. Some of these crimes are still under investigation.



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Gwent police break down recorded offences into specific groups to track crime patterns and allocate local resources. The following details outline the main differences between these categories.

- **Violence Against the Person (With or Without Injury):** This can include crimes of Assault, Threats, Coercive and Controlling Behaviour and Stalking and Harassment.
- **Public order offences:** Involve actions that disrupt community peace, such as brawls or incitement to hatred or could be persons swearing at each other in the street.
- **Criminal Damage and Arson:** Involve intentional, malicious damage to private and public property.
- **Acquisitive Crime (Theft from a Person or Theft Other):** Are crimes where the offender profits by stealing property, such as Burglary, Shoplifting, Bicycle Theft and Vehicle Crime.

The crime categories are as follows:

Criminal Damage & Arson	1	10%
Public Order Offences	1	10%

The above chart shows that for the last 28 days, there have been 5 different recorded crimes. The highest offences are violence without injury. There have been no concerning trends or patterns of note identified from August's statistics.



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Main Issues in the area for the month of August are:

- Play equipment in Rogiet Play Park has been vandalised with graffiti. Investigations have taken place, and unfortunately, at this time, no one has been identified.
- Residents have raised concerns about vehicles meeting and racing around the Rogiet Train Station Car Park. Police are aware and conducting regular patrols of the area.

Good Work

- Regular patrols have been taking place in the community on foot, targeting Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Hotspots.
