The crime data above shows the recorded incidents within the specific ward area for Rogiet.

Over the last month, 15 crimes have been recorded in Rogiet.

There has been an increase in the number of crimes reported in the Rogiet area from 6 to 15 since last month's report. Some of these crimes are still under investigation.



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The crime categories are as follows:

Residential Burglary	2	13%
Violence With Injury	2	13%
Criminal Damage & Arson	1	7%
Misc Crimes Against Society	1	7%
Public Order Offences	1	7%

The above chart shows that for the last 28 days, there have been 6 different recorded crimes. The highest offences are violence without injury. It should be noted that the increase in crime could be due to several factors, including ongoing reports from the same victims or multiple crimes arising from the same incident. There have been no concerning trends or patterns of note identified from June's statistics.

Main Issues in the area for the month of May are:

- A garage burglary took place near Chestnut Drive, Rogiet, where the unknown offenders forced entry and stole items in the middle of the night. Investigations have taken place, and the victims have been given safeguarding advice. Increased patrols have been taking place in the area. Crime prevention advice will be available at the next police surgery at Rogiet Community Junction.

Good Work

- Regular patrols have been taking place in the community on foot, targeting Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Hotspots. Furthermore, targeted patrols have taken place to combat parking issues.



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- PCSO Van Arkel and Richards attended Rogiet Primary School and spoke to year five about the subject of internet safety and bullying.
